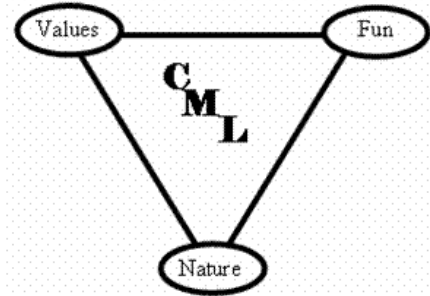
How it Works:

- Participants must be able to provide proof of household income by submitting a copy of a current tax form. (Federal 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ, or 1099).
- Membership payments must be paid in full for the year or monthly through an automatic draft of credit card or checking account.
- Annual or monthly membership fees will be based on total household income for individuals or families whose total household income is less than \$60,000 per year.
- *Membership for All Program* is good for all levels of membership the Hamden/North Haven YMCA offers.

- *Membership for All* is not mandatory, YMCA members or prospective members still have the option of paying the regular current membership fees.

Ultimate Adventure Camp: Entering Grades 3—9. This week will be filled with a variety of fun and challenging activities! Each day, the campers will board the YMCA bus and travel to a different destination to participate in a new activity. Trips may include sailing, tubing, cave exploration, canoeing, wake boarding, rock climbing, mountain biking, etc.

Animal Mania Camp: Entering Grades 1—6. During this week, the focus of the camp will be on broadening the campers' horizons as it pertains to a variety of animals and their natural habitats with daily activities centering around this theme. Educators from local wild life organizations, zoos, and aquariums will visit the camp and bring with them a variety of animals to educate the campers. Camp will culminate with a week-end trip to a local nature venue. This camp will run in two separate one week sessions; one focusing on land animals and one on sea life.

Karate Camp: Entering Grades 1—7. This week long camp will focus on a variety of aspects of the art of karate. A skilled instructor will be on hand to teach the campers about the art form as well as self-discipline and self-respect. The campers will be separated into two groups based on grade and skill level. Karate camp is a new offering this summer and everyone is looking forward to it!

More...Camp Mountain Laurel Specialty Camps!

Destination Fun Camp: Entering Grades 3—9. At this camp, children will travel throughout the state to different attractions and enjoy a variety of memorable experiences. They might visit a local beach, attend a baseball game, participate in water activities at a local venue, attend a movie, participate in bowling, visit the submarine base, or take in a science museum. Each day will be unique and fun-filled!

Outdoor Explorers Camp: Entering Grades 3—9. This week will be a nature lovers dream! The campers will enjoy a variety of experiences over the course of the week. Some of these activities may include: hiking at a local park, fishing, exploring marsh lands and streams, and visiting a local Audubon society.

Swim Camp: Entering Grades 2—7. Join the YMCA Typhoon Swim team coaches for a week of swim training...maybe you will be the next Olympic hero! This week's activities will focus on technique development; young swimmers will work to improve each of the four competitive strokes (freestyle, breast stroke, back stroke, and butterfly) while having some fun along the way!

Dino Adventures: Entering Grades 1—4. Become a paleontologist! Travel back in time to the days when dinosaurs roamed the earth! During this week long adventure the campers will explore, discover, and learn about dinosaurs and their habitat. Campers will partake in dino digs, creation of their own dinos and fossil finds. The day's activities will center around this theme with the appearance of guest speakers, educators and activities. The week long camp will culminate with a trip to a local museum. Traditional camp activities will also be incorporated into each day as well.

Science Camp: Entering Grades 1—8. If science is in your future, then you won't want to miss out on this exciting week at camp! We'll cover a variety of science themes over the course of the week—all culminating in a trip to a science museum at the end of the week!

Cheer Camp—Entering Grades 1—8. Come join the fun! CML is offering a cheer camp for the first time this summer. Our experienced cheer camp staff will lead the campers as they learn and develop cheering technique and cheer stunts—all with a focus on safety.

Dance Camp—Entering Grades 1—8. Come on, join the party! This week of camp will be filled with fun and music as the campers will have instruction on a number of dance styles. The week will end with a performance by the CML Dance Company (yes, that's you, Dance Campers!).

Do You Believe in Magic Camp—Entering Grades 1—4. Learn the basics of illusions from Magician Pat! This week of camp Pat will teach the campers some fun and exiting tricks of the magic trade! At week's end the campers will present the CML Magic Show—mesmerizing the entire camp community with feats of magical illusions and slight of hand!

Camp Mountain Laurel Adaptive Summer Camp

Hamden/North Haven YMCA's Camp Mountain Laurel is the ideal setting for special needs children to enjoy the fun of a traditional summer camp experience. The beautiful outdoor location sets the scene for camp fun and games to be played and an enriching experience to be enjoyed.



Camp Mountain Laurel's Adaptive Summer Camp program will provide campers with special needs the opportunity to attend summer camp each day - accompanied by a paraprofessional to enhance their camp experience. With the ever decreasing availability of special needs programming, the Y is pleased to offer our Adaptive Summer Camp program to help families meet their need for adequate and compassionate care for their children (kindergarten through grade 10) during the summer months. Campers participating in the Adaptive Summer Camp program will be integrated into our traditional day camp programs, participating in the programs, games, and activities with other children. The paraprofessional will be there every step of the way to assure that your camper has the same enriching experience that every camper should enjoy.

The enrollment process for the program will be similar to that of traditional day camp at CML. In addition to the required paperwork, a health form will be needed and an individualized care plan for each child will be developed. If medication is required during camp hours, the proper forms will need to be completed by the parent and child's physician. The medication that will need to be administered will also need to be provided to the program staff.

Pricing for the camp will be dependent upon camp selection as well as who will be providing the paraprofessional for the child at camp. For more information, a program consultation and/or to register your child, please contact Erin Kelly at 203 248 6361 or ekelly@cccymca.org.

General Information

The camp day begins at 9:00 a.m. and ends at 4:00 p.m. Each day includes at least 30 minutes of free swim and 30 to 40 minutes of swim instruction three days a week. Campers must bring their own lunches each day. Please remember that we are a peanut-free environment when preparing lunches. More specific information can be found in the parent handbook that each family receives upon registration for camp.

Transportation Included!

Convenient bus stops throughout Hamden, North Haven, and New Haven. Parents must supervise their children until the bus arrives. No child will be released to any adult who does not have proper I.D. and authorization. All busses are supervised by YMCA Camp Staff and are provided on a "space available" basis.

OUR STAFF

Who are our staff? Future teachers, educators and recreation professionals with a passion for making sure that every child who comes to YMCA Camp Mountain Laurel leaves more confident and with many new friends and stories. Eighty percent of our staff are 18 years old or older and each receives a minimum of 40 hours of training in safety, positive behavior management, activity planning, and more.

OUR PHILOSOPHY

We strongly believe that every child needs a safe and fun outdoor experience each and every day. Our program is designed to provide an outdoor environment where each child can learn and grow through a wide variety of exciting activities that promote growth and friendships. To these ends we maintain a strong commitment to building character in youth through our four core values of Caring, Honesty, Respect, and Responsibility.

Extended Care Options

The morning care program is operational from 7:30 – 9:00 a.m. Parents/Guardians must drop off their children at the H/NH YMCA Main Branch. Children dropped off before 8:45a.m. must be enrolled in the morning care program. The cost of this program will be \$70.00 per session. The afternoon extended care program is operational from 4:00 – 6:00 p.m. It will be held at Camp Mt. Laurel each day. The cost of this program will be \$70.00 per session. For families that are in need of both the morning and afternoon extended care programs, the cost will be \$120.00 per session.

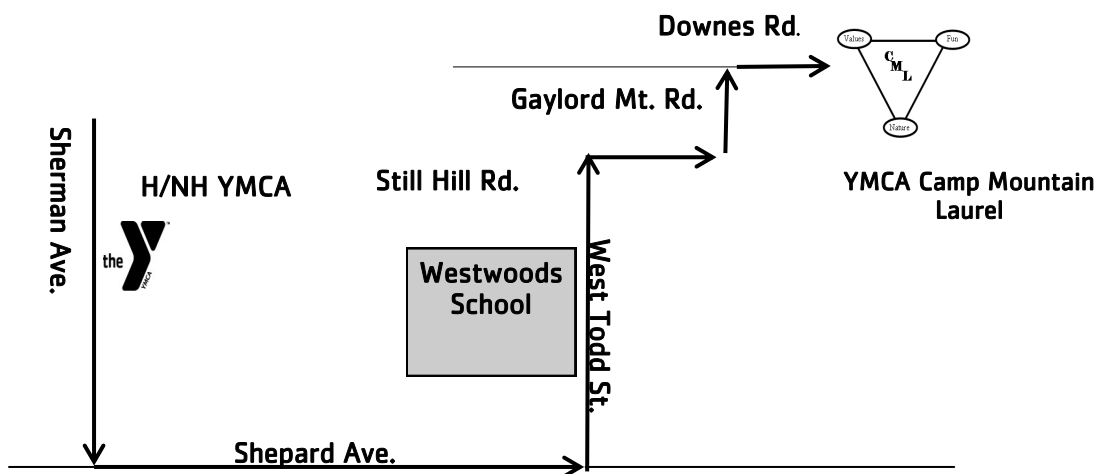

The Hamden/North Haven YMCA will be accepting applications for our *Counselors In Training Program*. Youth ages 14 and 15 are eligible to apply. Applications will be available in February 1, 2012 through the Membership Desk at the Y (1605 Sherman Avenue, Hamden).

There is a enrollment fee of \$50 per session. All applicants **MUST** be interviewed, provide three written recommendations (teacher, adult relative, clergy, etc.) and receive approval of the camp director prior to the start of the camp season. Once selected to participate, all CITs will participate in a pre-camp training session in June 2012 (regardless of which session(s) they are enrolled to attend).

Participants in our CIT Program learn and develop leadership skills, act as peer role models for younger campers, and have the opportunity to share their talents with the entire camp community. 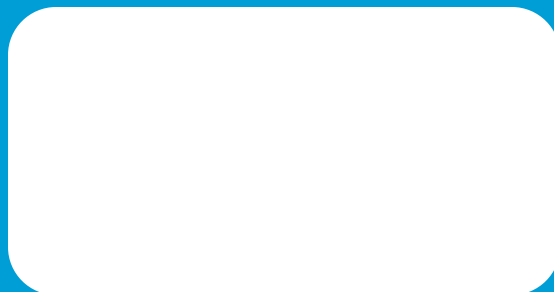
