To be sure all of our campers and staff are safe and have fun, we need your help in encouraging good behavior and following the four values of Caring, Respect, Honesty and Responsibility. Below are our rules and your responsibilities. We will be following policy. We expect your child to follow the camp rules. Please sign or return this form before camp begins.

Camper Rights

As a camper, you have the right to:

1. Be free from cruel teasing and put-downs;
2. Have camp as a calm, orderly place where you can feel safe and have fun;
3. Have a fair turn in any group activity;
4. Be free from fear of physical harm;
5. Make mistakes without being made fun of and have a chance to learn from those mistakes;
6. Get help from your counselor and all other camp staff;
7. Be treated with respect and dignity from everyone.

Camper Responsibilities

As a camper, you are expected to:

1. Avoid fights or name calling with other children;
2. Be fair with and welcome other campers who want to join in an activity;
3. Play and work safely;
4. Use appropriate and acceptable language;
5. Be Caring, Respectful and Honest towards others;
6. Be Responsible with equipment and materials, and share them fairly;
7. Respect the environment, wildlife, and property, especially things that don't belong to you;
8. Speak out when you see unfairness, offensive language or behaviors of others;
9. Cooperate with others and be a good sport when you win or lose;
10. Be truthful with everyone;
11. Leave valuables or electronic devices at home;
12. Not bring any tobacco products or other harmful substances onto YMCA property.

Most problems that come up are resolved through talking with campers and staff. If, however, the breaking of these rules continues, your parent/guardian will be notified to pick you up immediately. Parents must read the Parent Handbook and be familiar with suspension policies.

I will do my best to follow the camp rules, guidelines and responsibilities. I look forward to making this summer a good experience for myself, as well as for my fellow campers. I understand that failure to live up to my promise might result in my dismissal from camp.
