YOUTH ENRICHMENT CAMP

Before Camp, the Enrichment Camp Program and the Afternoon Recreation will all begin and end at Francis Walsh Intermediate School in Branford, CT – 185 Damascus Road. The After Camp Program will end at the Soundview Family YMCA.

By coordinating times and programs you can build a complete summer program for your child(ren). Here is a quick summary of the components and what they offer.

Before & After Camp Program (7-9 a.m. and 4-6 p.m.)

The Before & After Camp Program provides both morning (Pre-Camp Program) and afternoon (Post-Camp Program) opportunities during the entire summer. The morning portion of the program is 7:00-9:00 a.m. and the afternoon program is from 4:00-6:00 p.m. You can mix and match the coverage that you require for your child(ren). Registration for the Before & After Program is by the week only. Please note that there is no transportation provided for this programming. The Before Camp program is at Francis Walsh Intermediate School – 185 Damascus Road, Branford, and all children in the After Camp Program will be bussed to the Soundview Family YMCA.

Pre Camp: \$40 Per Week, Post Camp: \$40 Per Week

The Enrichment Camp Program (9 a.m. – 12 p.m.)

The Enrichment Camp Program operates for seven weeks of the summer. All programs are one week in duration. Some programs are offered more than once during the summer. Most Enrichment Programs operate from 9:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. five days a week. Some have extended day trips. Each opportunity builds around a central theme. Consult the individual summaries for details on each camp.

Afternoon Recreation (12 p.m. – 4 p.m.)

Afternoon Recreation is the perfect complement to the Enrichment Programs to make all day programming. The Afternoon Recreation Program runs from 12:00 p.m. (when Enrichment is over) to 4:00 p.m. Register by the week for great fun. We have taken the best arts and crafts, nature crafts, and recreational activities and combined them with the opportunity to swim at least once a week at the YMCA pool.
